Context

Newman Catholic College is a boys-only, comprehensive Catholic school situated in North West London, in one of the most socially deprived areas of our capital city. Vacancy

The Maths P8 score is even higher (1.679), placing our outstanding Mathematics department in the top quintile nationally for the third year in a row. Maths results in general have been consistently well-above the national average for the past 6 years, with GCSE 9-4s in 2019 at 64%.

Mathematics is taught in five dedicated classrooms, each incorporating an interactive whiteboard and a projector. We also benefit from a large, dedicated Maths staffroom, which allows us to work, plan and mark collaboratively: our department is intrinsically based on team work.

In Year 7 students are taught in mixed ability groups, and they are introduced to a coherently designed curriculum which aims at sequencing learning, and deepen understanding, rather than just cover content. This bespoke mastery-like approach continues through into Year 8, when students are grouped into ability groups. In

Years 9, 10 and 11 students follow the Edexcel Linear course and results are significantly above the national average. Our aim is to build on our success, and year on year improve outcomes for our learners.

We are seeking to appoint a well-qualified professional to teach Mathematics at all levels. This post provides an excellent opportunity to work in a high-quality, well-resourced and supportive environment and to be a part of a highly motivated team of teachers.
