### Purpose of post

To work as a member of the mathematics team to ensure high quality and inclusive mathematics learning for all students at Newman Catholic College.

### Context

Newman Catholic College is a boys, comprehensive Catholic school situated in North West London, one of the most socially deprived areas of London. Newman is much more than just a school: it is a multi-cultural community of people from different backgrounds with over 50 languages spoken amongst both staff and students. Everyone, student and staff alike, is nurtured and encouraged to thrive. We embrace our diversity and 'all faiths and cultures are warmly welcomed' (OFSTED, 2022).

Mathematics is taught in five dedicated classrooms, each containing an interactive whiteboard. We also have class sets of Chromebooks that can be used during lessons when appropriate. We benefit from a large, dedicated mathematics office, which allows

us to work, plan and mark collaboratively: our department is intrinsically based on teamwork.

Students are taught in mixed ability groups in key stage 3 to promote our core belief that, with the right scaffolding and support, every student can be successful in mathematics. In key stage 4 students follow the Edexcel GCSE course (GCSE grades 9-4 2022: 72%). We currently offer the Edexcel Mathematics in Context course for key stage 5 students. We take a mastery informed approach to pedagogy and follow a bespoke scheme of work that aims to promote a love of learning, improve students deep understanding of mathematics and, consequently, improve the retention of their learning.

We are seeking to appoint a well-qualified professional to teach mathematics at all levels. This post provides an excellent opportunity to work in a high-quality, well-resourced and supportive environment and to be a part of a highly motivated team of teachers.
