Simple steps to meditate.

This meditation exercise is an excellent introduction to meditation techniques.

- * Sit comfortably, feet flat on the floor and back against the chair.
- Read a passage from Scripture. Start with the Parables or a psalm
- * Close your eyes.
- * Simply breathe naturally.
- Focus your attention on the breath and on how the body moves with each inhalation and exhalation. Notice the movement of your body as you breathe. Observe your chest, shoulders, rib cage, and belly.
- Put yourself into the Bible story. Be part of the story, talk to people in the story. Spend time with Jesus. Be aware of the setting, etc.

- * If your mind wanders, return your focus back to your breath.
- * Have a conversation with God.


