I write following your Diversity Mark Assessment held on 18<sup>th</sup> March 2020. The assessment was completed by the assessor Manoj Soma. On visiting your school, the assessor was met by Mr Daniel Coyle (Head Teacher). The assessment visit included a site visit, structured interviews and a robust assessment of a portfolio of evidence.

I can now confirm following a Quality Assurance (QA) review of the recommendations of the lead assessor, the self-assessment report and portfolio of evidence that Newman Catholic College has been awarded the Diversity Mark Bronze Award.
