Enrichment learning: To bridge learning from online to back to school and understanding of how all subjects relate to and are used in real life – History, Maths, English and Science.

Playwriting: Creative expression of emotions during CV19. Performance on 13 August

Set Design: To illustrate their emotions, provide back drop to the play and learn useful practical skills.

Podcasting/broadcasting: skills for future jobs and expressing topical subjects

Exercise and Dance: Choreography, and movement to express emotions in context of – CV19, BLM, lockdown. Dance performance 13 August

Looking after animals: learning how to care for others through caring for animals and getting comfort from playing with them.

Kitchen Garden: Providing tomatoes, lettuce, corn and potatoes for students meals. Learning when vegetables first were used as food by humans. Being taught about water situations in the world today from pollution to over use and shared sources such as Renaissance Dam on Blue Nile.

Speakers: carefully selected speakers and specialists to run conversations, focusing on building self-confidence and resilience around the emotions and questions students want to discuss from lock down experience, lack of school, and BLM movement
