Overveiw

- 60 PP students returning to us from last year in years 8-11
- To include new year 7s and new project students
- Approx 20 legacy PP students in 6th and project

Identify:

- Pupil Premium provision map to be created, available on G-Drive
- Student picture, concerns, interventions and strategies
- All staff to be aware of PP students in classes, forms etc and their intervention

SIMs analysis:

- View the data from last year's PP behaviour report
- Tailored interventions for the school PP- not uniform but DB, IHW, MD
- Not all students need same intervention- OF & DDT opportunities driven different to TP and SH

External:

- Build contacts with successful organisations methods that work
- Humanutopia vs Challenge the Gap? Pros and cons HU-leg and mpp CTG-EAL+
- HU day £2250 per day, CTG £8500 year subscription (9 student pp allowance)

Legacy:

- Former pp students (12 & 13) to "buddy" with ks3 PP students.
- Motivate younger students and give legacy experience for UCAS etc.
- ASDAN peer mentor programme (10-60 hours) challenge checklist
- £19.15 per student on course. £400 for 7 & 8 to have individual buddy (1/2 a PP student yearly allowance).

10 Top Tips:

1. Know your PP students- the list changes regularly
2. Mark PP student books first/last
3. Tactical seating plans/groupings
4. Plan homework tactically- what facilities can the student access?
5. Specific and target interventions in and out of lessons and school
6. Measure impact, document successes
7. Work collaboratively and have PP department links.
8. Build positive relationships.
9. Inspire ambition and future aspirations.
10. Communicate with Department leaders, Heads of school an PP coordinator.
