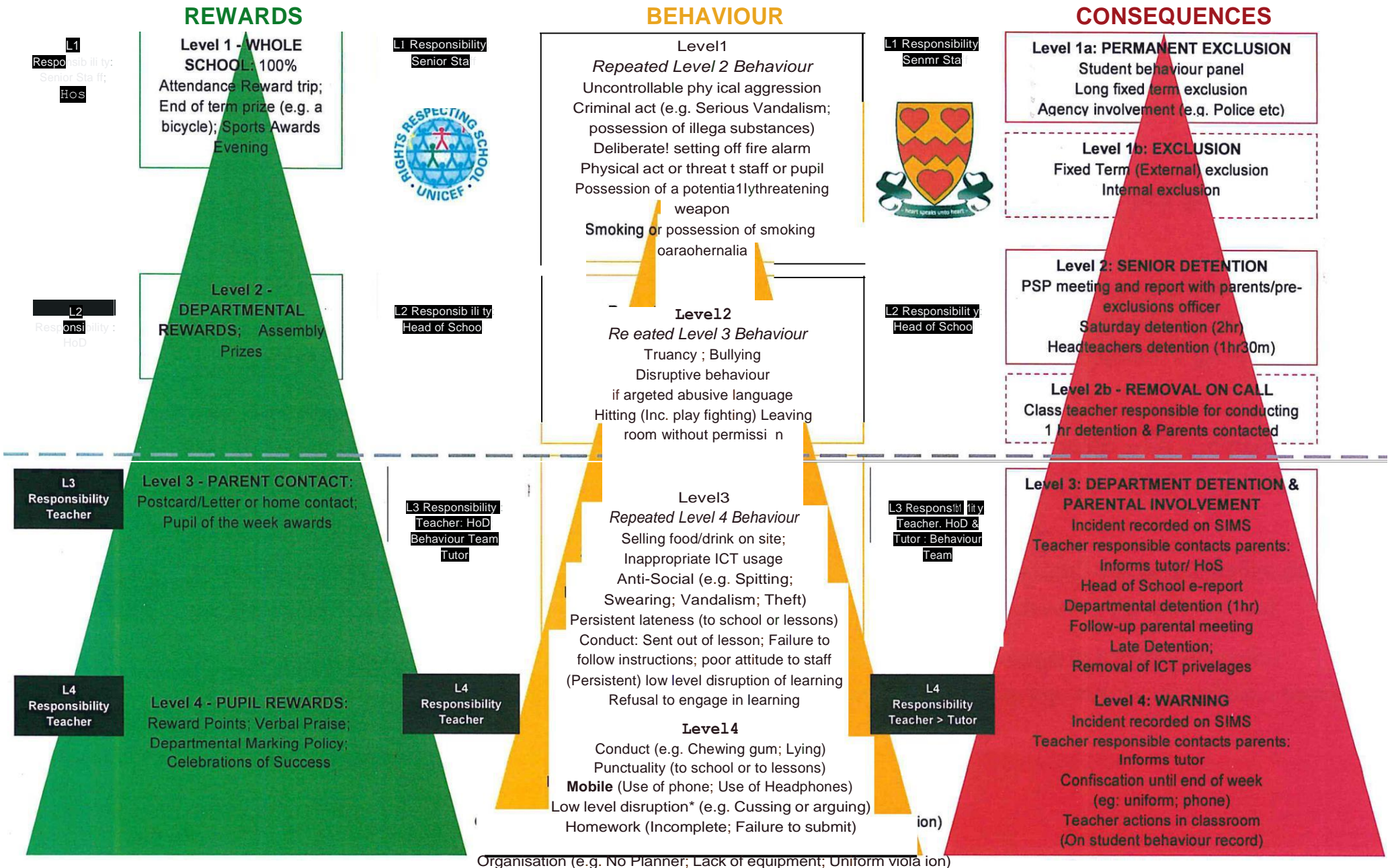

N CC-Behaviour for Progress: Zero Tolerance

Zero tolerance means whole-staff commitment to stringent implementation of the Behaviour for Progress policy in registration lessons and around the school. Student opposition to this results in a L2 consequence.



WATER-ONLY ZONE - Only tap water can be brought into school (No flavoured water or ANY other drinks). Water must ONLY be in clear reusable bottles. Canteen will sell only bottled water. Staff will search pupils' bags if re"quired. Staff will confiscate and dispose of non-water drinks. Staff decision final.

JUNK FOOD FREE ZONE - Food may only be brought into school in a packed lunch box. Example foods allowed: One packet of Crisps (Maximum 35g) packet/One chocolate biscuit; Staff will search pupils' bags if required; Staff will confiscate and dispose of any junk food. Staff decision final.



BULLYING (as per Anti-Bullying Policy) - Any type of bullying to be dealt with as a L2 behaviour with L2 consequences. Anti-Bullying Association defines bullying as "*...the repetitive, intentional hurting of one person or group by another person or group, where the relationship involves an imbalance of power. Bullying can be physical, verbal or psychological. It can happen face-to-face or through cyberspace.*"



UNIFORM (as per Uniform Policy - see planner) - Full Blazer, Shirt, Tie, Trousers, Black polished shoes (No non-uniform items allowed).

EQUIPMENT (as per Equipment Policy - see planner) - Planner & Pencil Case containing: Pens, Pencils, Ruler, Sharpener, Rubber minimum.

DISRUPTING LEARNING (as per Behaviour for Progress Policy) - Any disruption impacting on learning in class
