Catholic Life

NCC6 continues the practices from the main Newman Catholic College. All NCC6 students attend the General RE courses in both Year 12 and 13. The courses are relevant to the world we live in, are academic and ensure that our students maintain and develop a spiritual element in their lives. We provide a daily act of worship in form rooms and assemblies throughout the year.

Assemblies are held for year 12 and 13 students once a week, with key themes marking out significant points in the year, such as the start of the academic year, Advent, Christmas, Remembrance Day and Holocaust Memorial Day.

Assemblies are usually led by the Principal, the SLT, Heads of Year or House Groups. Students often take an active role. As we are a school committed to the UNICEF Rights Respecting School Award, a different right is a focus in the weekly assembly theme. The school provides opportunities for our Catholic students to receive the sacraments during the academic year such as the sacrament of reconciliation.


