





What message do you think Saint John Henry Newman would give to students about learning today?








Fact Seven




Once the two miracles were formally recognised Pope Francis had to declare Newman a Saint

Newman's Miracles-To be recognised as a Saint, two miracles needed to be associated with Newman

- In 2001, 62-year-old John (Jack) Sullivan, who had prayed to Newman was miraculously cured from lumbar disc disease that had produced severe pain and incapacity to walk. A study by physicians concluded that there was no medical explanation for the man's instantaneous cure, and in 2009, the Holy See approved the cure as a miracle attributed to the intercession prayers of Newman.
- The second miracle attributed to Newman, occurred in May 2013. An pregnant mother, Melissa Villalobos, was suffering from unstoppable internal bleeding which threatened the life of her child in the womb and in prayer she directly and explicitly asked for Newman's intercession to stop the bleeding. The miraculous healing was immediate, complete, and permanent.






Newman Values

We actively encourage & promote the use of the English language by students at all times





Newman's Teachings on Education

- A student's studies are all-important study both the arts and sciences, All education is important
- Human flourishing: the making of men they had not come to made doctors, engineers, lawyers or priests, but in order "to be made men" you to flourish at all levels.
- Guidance on the art of living well You must fill you heart, soul, mind and brain.
- Daily Christian living Daily practices of Christian worship to allow spiritual growth to take place. Prayer, meditation, self-examination and the reading of Scripture.
 - Deepening in Christian knowledge students should have a general knowledge of history, philosophy and literature, and know of sacred history, Christian philosophy (and theology), and biblical literature.
