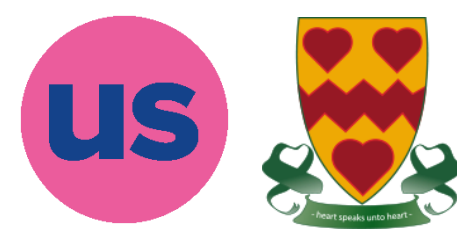

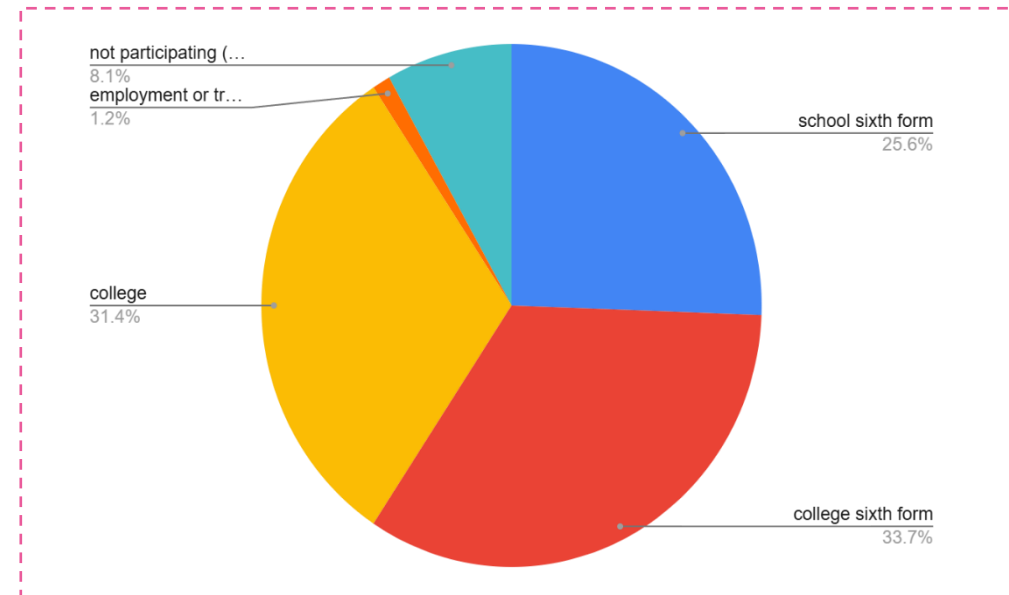

A total of 84 Year 11 students progressed from Newman Catholic College in 2024–2025, all of whom are male. The vast majority have moved into full-time education across school sixth forms, sixth form colleges and further education colleges, with a small number entering employment or training and a small group whose destinations are still being finalised.

School sixth forms account for 20 students, with a further 29 progressing to sixth form colleges and 25 to general FE colleges. 3 students have moved directly into employment or training. 7 students are currently recorded as NEET, with destinations to be confirmed and continue to receive targeted support to secure a sustained post-16 outcome.
